Greetings to all in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Praise the Lord for His goodness and mercy. We are definitely in the heat of summer; however we are thankful to God for his blessings. We have had the honor of serving Him in several prison meetings. May was our busiest month, traveling more than 2400 miles for meetings. In May we were able to have a one-time service at the Albemarle Correctional Institution. We had 109 inmates in attendance. Ann was able to sing and I preached the message. The Lord blessed and one precious man accepted the Lord as his Savior. Last week we heard from the chaplain and he has given us the opportunity to do a monthly service there. Praise the Lord! We had services at these units also: Marion, Wilkes, Craggy, North Piedmont Women and Tabor City. In June we were in Southern Correctional Men, Mt View, and Wilkes. On June 26th we held a Youth Rally at the South Iredell High School auditorium. There were about 100 in attendance and the service was good with one young person saved. Pastor Phillip Moore of the Cherry Grove Baptist Church in Moravian Falls moderated and His family sang. Also Chloe Smith, our granddaughter, The Elder Sister, and Jordan Carter sang. I was not able to be there for the entire service due to the passing of my brother, Donnie Jones. Please pray for his family. Brother Jacob Scott, a local youth evangelist delivered the message. July was busy as well with services in Buncombe, Mt View, Wilkes, Marion, and Tabor City. Our teams have been in Lincoln, Catawba, Craggy, North Piedmont, Gaston Juvenile, Southern Correctional and Livesay. There have been 52 precious souls saved this year. Many of the inmates come up for prayer desiring a closer walk with God and be a better witness for Him.

Ann and I continue to visit churches to present the needs for the ministry. It has been difficult raising support as many people are losing income and their jobs, but God is still able to meet the needs of His people. Pray for us as we travel and raise our support.

The Collection of the Saints Ministry program is going well with Brother Miles Griffin and Brother Daniel Scarberry helping families with food, clothing and baby items. A back-to-school day is planned for August 14th at the Rockwell Baptist Church in Mooresville. We are accepting donations of school supplies for the children of needy families. We appreciate all your prayers and financial support in this effort.
