God is doing great things for us in these days and we are thankful to our Lord for his provisions for us. We have had four new Churches take us on for support this year and that brings our support level up to almost 60 %. We are thankful to all of you that pray for and support our ministry. We could not do what we do if it were not for you. We have had several of you help us get into meetings where there is the possibility of raising support. Thank you for your recommendations and encouragement in this area as well. I would also like to say thank you to Calvary Baptist Church of Bedford, Va. for the offering toward our mission trips this year. We have been in 12 units these two months, where **we saw 12 men make professions of faith** in the Lord. We were able to hold Revivals in Livesay Correctional and Lincoln Correctional, where we had good attendance in each service, with many men coming to the altar to get help. One thing that has been a burden to us this year is the amount of men raising their hand that they are lost, but not moving during the invitation. Please help us pray for God to bring them to Him. At the Revival at Livesay Correctional, we had a Muslim man named John come to each service and we saw God at work in his heart. Please pray for his salvation. The Chaplain told us that he has been to every Christian Service for about a month and is searching.

On March 2, I was walking into Wal-Mart in Hickory, just before I got to the door, a white car pulled up in front of me and the driver rolled down the window and asked if I was Joe Hendricks. When I answered, "yes", he began to smile and said, "Joe, I am Tim, remember me". When he began to smile, I remembered him from Lincoln Correctional. For the next several minutes he began to tell me how good God had been to him in **the 3 years since his release**. He said, "I got my wife back, my home back, my license back, a car and a good job." He told me he was attending a Baptist Church and trying to get into Alexander Correctional as a Volunteer. Here is just one testimony of what your Mission dollars are doing. Only Eternity will reveal what God is doing in the lives of those behind bars because of your love for them. **To God be glory for great things He is doing.**

We have a busy next couple of months in the Prisons as well as in the Communities. We have our regular schedule in the Prisons and also a Revival at Wilkes Correctional. We also have a Tent meeting at New Grace Baptist Church in Iron Station., our Home Church, on April 11-14. I will be preaching a Revival at Refuge Missionary Baptist Church in Hudson, May 2-5. If you are in the area, we would invite you to come to the Tent meeting and the Revival. We have also had the opportunity to help several of you in services already this year. Thank you for letting me be a help to you. If there is any way that I can help any of you, please let me know.

On March 5, we were blessed with our fifth grandchild. Elana Grace Hardy was born to Tonya and Sam. Both the Mother and Baby are doing fine. In closing, please remember my Mom and Dad.
